







Prevention of illness after-effects and health problems in childhood in University Hospital Olomouc

(Information on the project implementation)

Management and monitoring of the project

The process of selection of a supplier took place as follows:

On 11/03/2015 University Hospital Olomouc called four companies to submit offers for the supply of management and monitoring of the project, namely GRANTIKA České spořitelny, a.s., EU Via, a.s., RENARDS, s.r.o. and Quartus spol. s.r.o.

The estimated value of the contract was fixed at maximum of 25,000 CZK excl. VAT. The evaluation criterion for the tender was the lowest price (incl. VAT) offered.

Within the deadline for submission of offers, the contracting authority received only one offer from EU Via, a.s. (address: Nad Buďánkami II 1841/17, 150 00 Prague 5 – Smíchov) with the total price of 15,000 CZK excl. VAT, i.e. 18,150 CZK incl. VAT), and accepted it.

The contract was signed on 11/05/2015.

Equipment supply

The tender on supply of equipment (specified below) was implemented in an open tender procedure.

On 24/02/2015 the tender was announced. It has been divided into four individual parts under the provision of section 98 of the Public Procurement Act no. 137/2006:

Part I. Retina camera

Part II. Ultrasound device

Part III. Pressure-mapping equipment

Part IV. Resuscitation equipment

The tender has been published on the contacting authority's profile and in the Czech Tender Journal. The initial deadline for the submission of offers was 21/04/2015. The deadline had to be postponed to 12/05/2015 due to an additional information received.

Parts I., II. and III. were evaluated in terms of price and contracts with the winners were signed on 02/07/2015. Currently, supplies of the individual devices take place.

Part IV. was cancelled under the provision of section 84 par. 1 a) of the Public Procurement Act no. 137/2006. The reason for cancellation of this part was that no offers were submitted.

Therefore, the tender for the supply of resuscitation equipment had to be retaken.

In fact it was the repetition of Part IV but it was held separately as small-scale contract because the subject of this part is different from the subjects of Parts I., II. and III. of the preceding open procedure tender. The tender was then published on 11/06/2015 as small-scale contract called "Supply of resuscitation equipment". However, even this small-scale contract was cancelled because truly different and incomparable offers were submitted which had been caused by ambiguous assignment of technical parameters in the call.

The tender had to be retaken again as "Supply of resuscitation equipment II." and was published on 10/07/2015. The problematic technical parameters were modified and clearly specified. The estimated value of the contract was fixed at of 1,665,224.79 CZK excl. VAT, i.e. 2,014,922 CZK incl. VAT. The evaluation criterion for the tender was the lowest price (incl. VAT) offered. The tender was evaluated in terms of price and the winning supplier was S&T Plus s.r.o. (Business ID: 25701576) with total price of 2,010,294 CZK incl. VAT. The contract was signed on 11/08/2015.

Educational leaflets (brochures)

Selection of the supplier for the production and printing of educational leaflets:

University Hospital Olomouc called four companies to submit offers for the production and printing of educational leaflets. The estimated value of the contract was set at maximum of 7,500 CZK excl. VAT. The evaluation criterion for the tender was the lowest price (incl. VAT) offered.

Within the deadline for submission of offers, the contracting authority received four offers.









They were evaluated in terms of price and the most favorable of them was the one from ZAFI CZ spol. s.r.o. that offered 6,450 CZK excl. VAT. An order to ZAFI CZ spol. s.r.o. was sent. The leaflets were delivered in the required quantity. Currently, they are being distributed to parents of newborns and published on the website of University Hospital Olomouc (www.fnol.cz).

Courses – training in resuscitation

Courses were launched in July 2015. They include practical training and simulation of individual resuscitation activities and are suitable both for parents of newborns as well as for medical staff.
